




Our Mexagonal Split Bamboo Rods

have become so popular that it has started a host of people to imitate them, and as they have neither our experience or the proper bamboo, they turn out inferior work. Anglers are very often prejudiced against Split Bamboo Rods from this very reason. They get hold of some cheap, or even expensive substitute, attracted by some puff, or loud sounding advertisement, and the rod turning out badly, they think that ALL Split Bamboo Rods are inferior. It is much easier for amateurs to make wooden rods, for as we shall show the making of GOOD Split Bamboo requires great skill and experience, in addition to well seasoned and choice material.

In the first place we have a great advantage over all manufacturers in having the largest and choicest selection of well seasoned Bamboo in the country. In making up our rods we use only absolutely perfect canes. Small makers cannot do this, for the remainder is useless, and would cause them a heavy loss, while we can put it to many uses in our Factory. This is the reason so much burnt and other unfit Bamboo is found in rods of other makers.

Some makers claim that it is best to use the lower part of the cane for the butt, the next section for the middle joint, and so on. Now this is an error, and they do this for the sake of economy, and not for the reason that it is better. The butt, as every one knows, is much the toughest and hardest, and this part only we use in our rods.

As to the number of strips that should be used in making these rods, we claim that our principle of using six is the best, for the simple reason that the strips in a Hexagonal Rod are even on all sides, that is each strip is in shape of an equilateral triangle, thereby making the strongest possible combination, getting the greatest amount of enamel and least quantity of cement. A tip made of 8 pieces contains almost as much cement as cane.



Out No. 1 shows a transverse section of the cane, and the dotted lines where a piece is split out. It is then planed down to the light line, leaving only the hard enamel.

No. 2 shows the strips ready for cementing, and No. 3 when cemented together.

Our cement used in these rods is waterproof and after once dried it is impossible to separate the strips. The circle on Cut 3 shows how much of the best part of the enamel is lost in making a rod "round," thereby not only weakening it and making the action uneven, but also destroying to a great extent, its waterproof quality, for the enamel is in itself a great protection against the influence of dampness.

Our Rods are joined so carefully and closely that the jointings are almost imperceptible, in addition they are varnished with the finest varnish, made expressly for this purpose, rendering them absolutely waterproof. It is much easier to make a round rod, as it requires less skillful workmanship, the file making up for any defect in joining. We therefore claim to give a better Rod for a less price, than any other maker of Split Bamboo Rods, and as a result have a constant and increasing demand, not only here, but also in Europe, for this favorite style of Rod.

These Rods are guaranteed hand made, no machinery used in their manufacture.








Actual Size of No. 31/2 Combined Multiplying Click and Drug Rubber and German Silver Conroy Black Bass Reel.

Actual Size of No. 4 Rubber and German Silver Click Reel.


