**T**HE best Striped Bass Fishermen of the Jersey coast, where most of the surf casting is done, have put our reel to hard usage during two seasons, and the many complimentary letters sent us prove that the reel is what we claim it to be. The 1913 model will be found to differ but little from the 1912 reel, the changes being in the strengthening of those parts where use has shown additional strength to be advisable.

The simple mechanism and rigid construction of this new model will commend it to the anglers who delight in the invigorating sport of surf casting. Its automatic drag acts only when the fish runs—never while you are reeling in your line, and you may adjust the tension of this drag to suit yourself.

To take it apart—just push the button and twist your wrist. In two seconds you can get at the mechanism to clean or oil it.

A better salt water reel in design, construction and practical usefulness cannot be made.

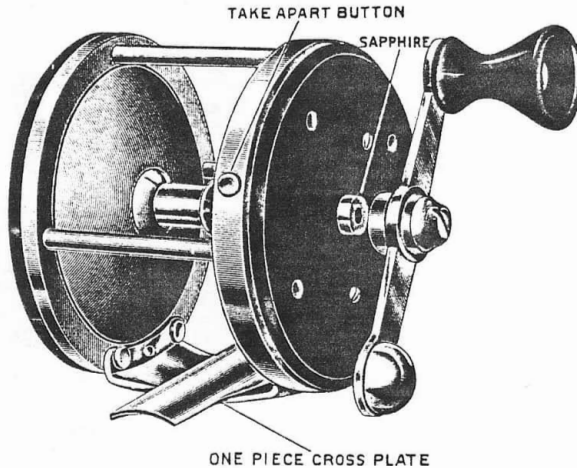

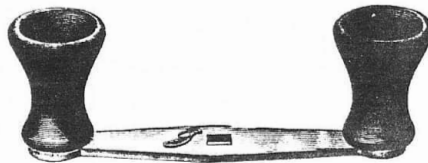

SINCE the introduction of our "Deep Sea" Reel (page 11), we have had many requests for a similar reel of smaller size, capable of holding (filled full) six hundred feet of nine thread Cuttyhunk Line, with sufficient strength for the hard work of heavy salt water fishing, and still light enough not to "over-weight" the light rods now so much used for that type of fishing.

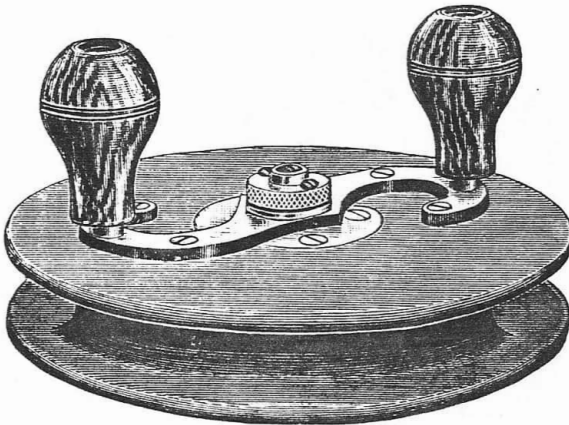
To the officers and members of the Catalina Island Fishing Club is due much credit for their pioneer advocacy of this lighter tackle, and the "NEPTUNE" Reel was especially designed to meet the needs of the anglers of that section. It is appropriate, however, for any style of fishing, fresh or salt water, where a reel of this capacity is needed. For Muscallonge trolling it is ideal. And in Muscallonge fishing, as well as in salt water fishing, the AUTOMATIC DRAG will be found to assist materially in playing the "big fellows," as the drag acts against the fish—not against the angler.



Double Grip Handle

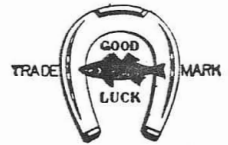

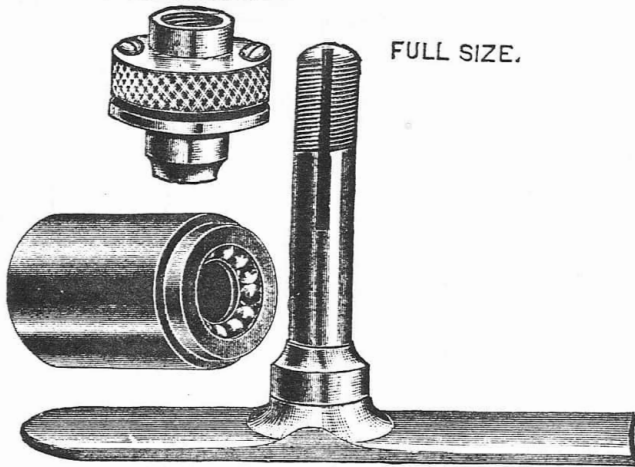

These reels are used for deep trolling with wire line or other lines in fresh water fishing, and are very popular for salt water fishing. Because of the large diameter of the spool, the line is reeled in rapidly, with no loss of power.

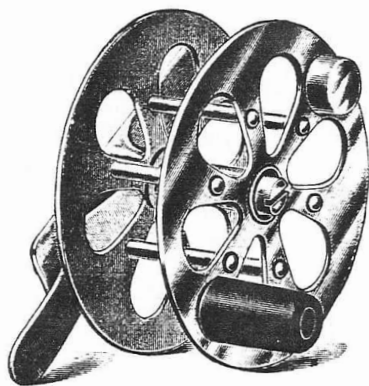

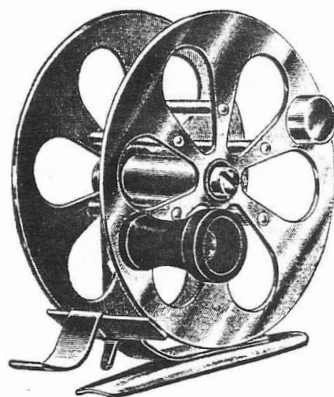


## "Amateur" Reels

THE simplicity of these reels permits a low manufacturing cost. They are the cheapest reels we make but are assembled with care by the workmen who make the more expensive "Featherlight" and "Expert" Reels. They may be depended on to give good service—much more service than can be had from multiplying reels sold at about the same prices. Being single action reels they afford greater power than multiplying reels, with less exertion, and as the spools are of large diameter, speed is not sacrificed. The sides are perforated and the line dries quickly on the reel. All bearings are made of steel.

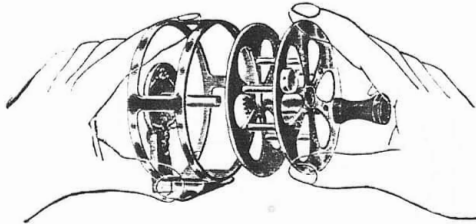

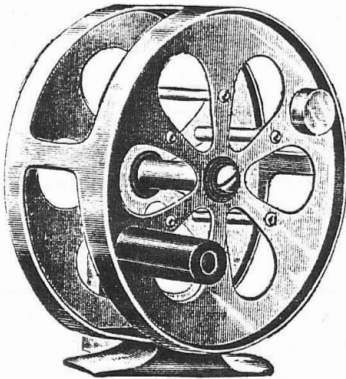
## “Expert” Reels

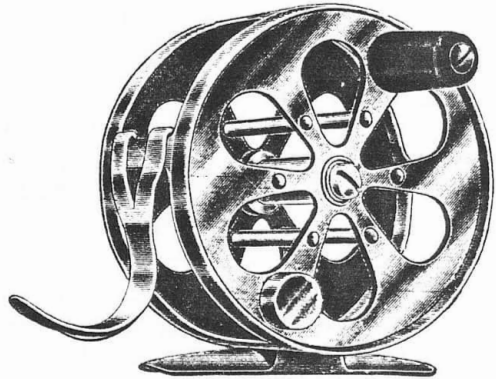
The bearings and all wearing parts are made of steel.

The click is made of Hardened Steel, equaled only in the most expensive reels, and is not to be compared with clicks in other low-priced reels.



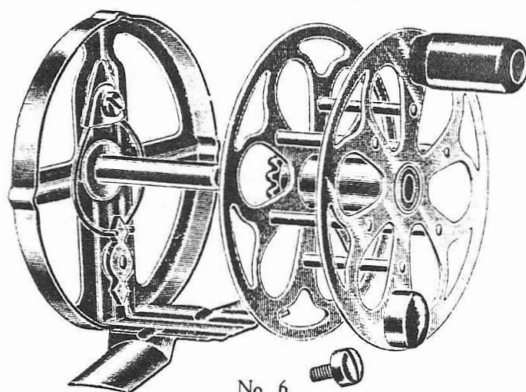

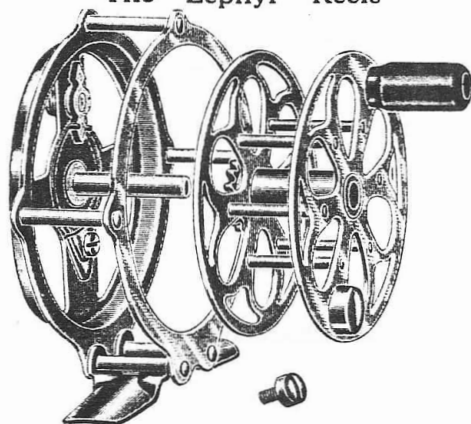
