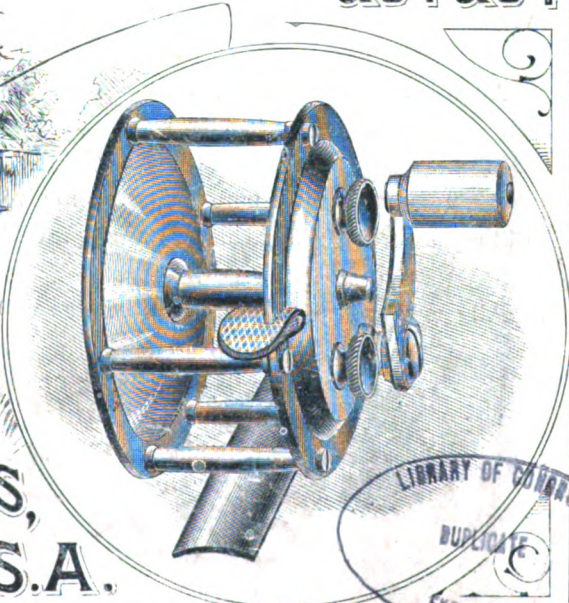

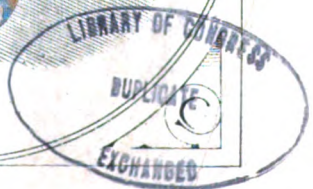

HOW TO ORDER.

Address your letter carefully. Write your name and address distinctly.

As far as possible order rods, trimmings, etc., by number or letter. Mention the amount of money you inclose.

United States postage stamps accepted in payment for goods to the amount of \$1, but we cannot use foreign stamps. The safest modes of remitting money are by express, draft, money order, or registered mail.

Parties ordering will find it much cheaper to remit the cost of goods with the order, thus saving return express charges on money.

In all cases where money accompanies the order, if the goods do not prove to be entirely satisfactory, the same can be exchanged, or money will be refunded if so desired.

Goods in lots less than one-half dozen will be charged by the piece.

All telegraph communications to be sent to White River Junction, Vt.

GOODS BY EXPRESS.

We send goods by express C. O. D., with privilege of examining, but parties so ordering must in all cases send money sufficient to defray all charges if goods are returned to us. The money advanced in such instances will be deducted from the amount of C. O. D. bill.

GOODS BY MAIL.

Most goods in our catalogue can be sent by mail as merchandise, at the rate of one cent per ounce. Customers ordering by mail will please inclose stamps for postage, unless goods are advertised postpaid.

Stain, polish and varnish are unmailable. Packages weighing over four pounds are unmailable.

Merchandise packages can be registered for 10 cents each.

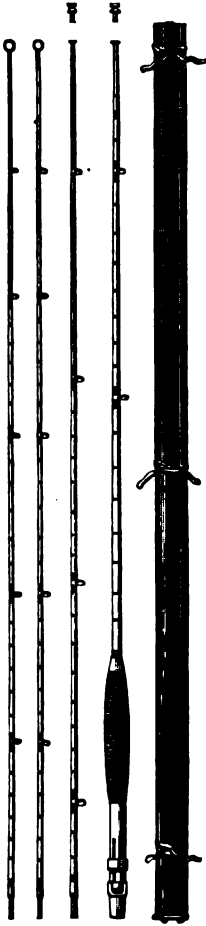

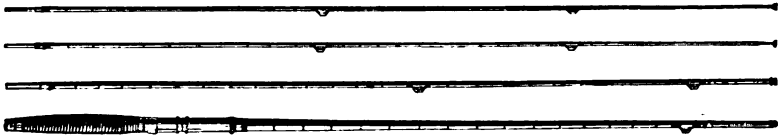

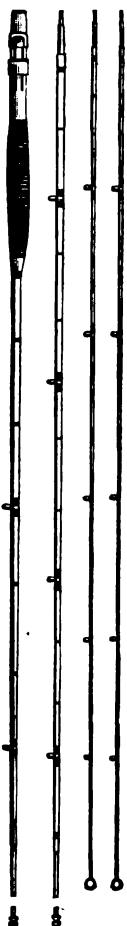

We believe that with the exception of split bamboo, good lance wood is the "par excellence" of all wood for fishing rod purposes, having that power of elasticity combined with strength, we believe, to a greater degree than any other wood used in the manufacture of rods.

We leave all lance wood in its natural color, and finish with Chubb's improved varnish, which is impervious to water, making them waterproof. These rods are well made and well balanced, have Chubb's best trimmings, solid metal reel seat, well-fitting ferrules, and are first class in every respect. This reel has raised disc, covered by letters patent No. 13,921, granted May 22, 1883, which makes a stronger reel and allows room for a better click than the old style, also has Chubb's improved click spring which is riveted to the plate, and is not soldered as is the case in other reels. In most reels the first thing to give out is the click; this is caused by heating the spring in soldering, by which the temper of the spring is destroyed, or by imperfectly soldering the spring to the plate, so that it soon gets loose and the reel is laid aside for repairs. 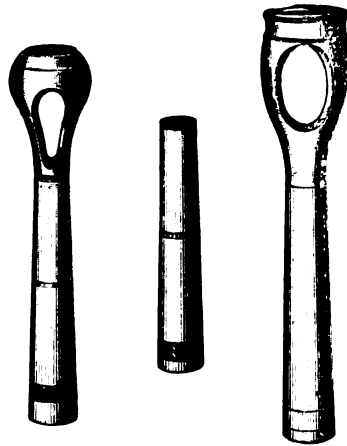

STAIN AND POLISH.

Directions for Preparing the Wood, and Applying our Stain and Polish.—Fill the grain of the wood with whiting and water, mixed to a thin paste; allow the filling to dry before removing the surplus, which can be done with lubricating oil. Dry the surface with a cloth. Apply the Stain and Polish with a wad, made of cotton stocking, until a sufficient number of coats have been applied to give a good body for rubbing down. Give ample time between each coat of the Stain and Polish to allow it to dry. If a very nice polish is desired, rub the surface smooth with pulverized pumice stone and water; after drying and removing the pumice stone, rub briskly with the dry hand, which will give a high polish. 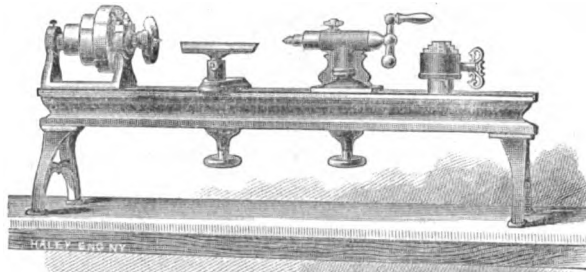

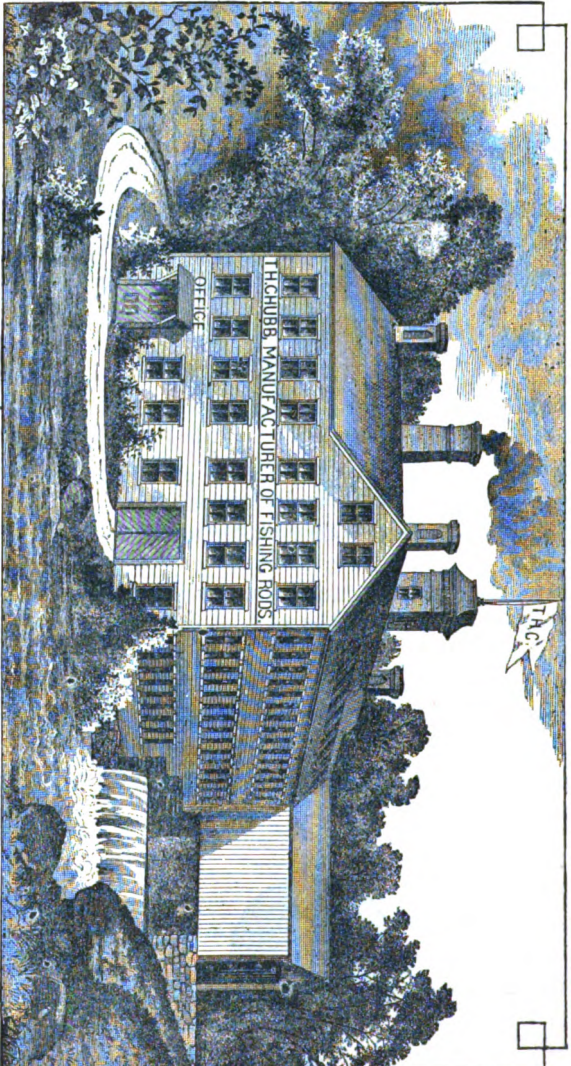
